Eligibility Criteria to apply:

Students must have:

- **GPA \geq 3.0:** A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 on a scale where 4.0 is the highest and/or a class standing of no less than the top 30% evidenced by an official transcript of grades or written statement from a school administrator.
- **Three letters of recommendation**, following the criteria below:
 - From an instructor or faculty advisor.
 - From a current or past employer.
 - From a character reference.

*In the case of schools with an ASHRAE student branch, a letter from the faculty advisor of that branch may be one of the three letters of recommendation.
- Potential service to the HVAC and/or refrigeration profession.
- Financial need.
- Excellence, Character, Leadership qualities.
- Service to the community & others, and/or extracurricular activities. This can include participation in the arts, music, athletics, volunteerism, environmental/humanitarian groups, or other service organizations.

Tips for ASHRAE Scholarship Applicants:

- **Become an ASHRAE student member** (<https://www.ashrae.org/membership/join>). Though not required for scholarship eligibility, a student membership will provide you with valuable resources, opportunities, and connections that will help you in your chosen career path.
- Make sure you meet all the criteria.
- Make sure you submit the application and all required documents on or before the applicable deadline.
- Include a brief, non-required introductory cover letter.
- Be clear and thorough when stating goals, financial need and answering essay questions.
